## Participation Agreement

With in-class recycling and school-wide collection, this hands-on program empowers students to engage and educate their school community about the 3R's:

**Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.**

**Thank you for your decision to implement the 3R's School Recycling Program at your school. Your signature below indicates that you have reviewed and agree to the following rules.**

- 1) Your school will have a designated student group and school advisor overseeing the implementation of the program on campus.
- 2) The Kōkua Hawai'i Foundation (KHF) and its partners are not liable for any injuries or losses that may occur as a result of your school's participation in the 3R's School Recycling Program.
- 3) As stated on your Recycling Bin Inventory Form, all recycling bins loaned to your school are the sole property of KHF and your school will be liable for any losses or damage to aforementioned KHF property.
- 4) Bins must remain on campus at all times. They are provided for the express purpose of recycling on campus; any school recycling bins not used for recycling should be returned promptly to KHF.
- 5) Schools will be charged a fee for lost or damaged recycling bins provided by the Kōkua Hawai'i Foundation. (\$10 per 12.5 gallon classroom bin, \$150 per green 95 gallon rolling bin)

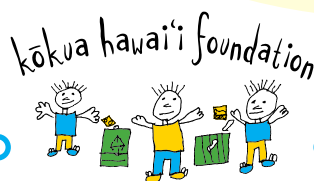
