SCHOOL & COMMUNITY PRESENTATIONS, FILM SCREENINGS AND WORKSHOPS

 PFH offers presentations and campaign planning to schools and community groups.
 Presentations include facts and hands-on activities on single-use plastics, marine debris,



recycling, and solutions to plastic pollution.

- PFH hosts film screenings of documentaries related to plastic and waste reduction.
- PFH offers educational, hands-on workshops to empower people to live more plastic free.

PLASTIC FREE SERVICES

PFH provides consulting for schools, events, restaurants, businesses and nonprofit organizations that would like to achieve plastic free and zero waste goals.

PFH offers resources and services including our PFH Water Refill Stations, PFH Plastic Free Products Guide, and more to facilitate elimination of single-use plastic distribution at events.

BEACH CLEANUPS

PFH and our partners host beach cleanups throughout the year to encourage schools and community members to keep our coastlines clean and to inspire participants to reduce use of single-use plastics in their daily lives. Beach cleanups are typically hosted on the North Shore and on the Windward coast of Oʻahu, where the



majority of marine debris on Oʻahu washes ashore.

PLASTIC FREE MERCHANDISE

Our retail selection includes many reusable items including: Tote Bags, Sporks, Utensil Sets, Water Bottles, Cups, Straws, and Lunchboxes! KHF has an online store and partners with over a dozen local retail businesses to distribute merchandise and simultaneously raise funds to support KHF's mission.

KHF also supports events with PFH donations and wholesale ordering for outreach, prizes and fundraising efforts.

PARTNERSHIPS

Kōkua Hawai'i Foundation partners with many local, national & international organizations to achieve our PFH program goals. Key partners include:

- **5 Gyres**: empowers action against the global health crisis of plastic pollution through science, art, education, and adventure.
- **808 Cleanups**: volunteers clean graffiti and litter from Hawai'i's parks, trails, reefs and beaches.
- Algalita: the leading marine debris research group on plastic pollution provides extensive restoration and educational resources.
- **BYOBottle**: a music industry effort to turn the tide on plastic pollution by promoting reusable water bottles and refill stations at music events worldwide.
- **Countercurrent**: fostering ocean stewardship through science-based public art installations and youth workshops.
- Hawai'i Environmental Cleanup Coalition (HECC): a coalition of 11 cleanup organizations in Hawai'i which enhances collaboration, data collection and outreach about cleanup activities.
- NOAA's Hawai'i Marine Debris Action Plan: establishes strategic action to reduce the ecological, health and safety, and economic impacts of marine debris in Hawai'i by 2020. Coordinated by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Marine Debris Program.
- Love Letters to the Sea: an arts integrated, creative letter writing projects that promotes positive change for our ocean by empowering students to take action, promote innovation, and use their voices to drive policy solutions.
