### Criteria:

- 1. Teach full time at an **eligible <u>Equity Focus</u> public school, public charter school, or Head Start center.** For more information on whether your school qualifies check out this <u>article</u>.
- 2. You have not received previous funding on DonorsChoose.
- 3. Create a Music & Arts <u>project request</u> for the following materials: musical instruments and art supplies. Here are some examples:
  - Art supplies for your classroom such as acrylic paint sets, watercolor sets, brushes, canvases, drawing paper, sketchbooks, easels, ect
  - Providing a classroom set of instruments such as ukuleles, drums, guitars, tambourines, ect
  - Digital art tools including tablets with styluses and graphic design software licenses to integrate modern art techniques into your curriculum
- 4. Keep your total project goal **under \$600**, including taxes, shipping, fees, and the suggested donation to support DonorsChoose.
- 5. Once your project is approved, **donations will be doubled** while funding remains. That means a \$25 donation will become a \$50 donation!

#### What can I ask for?
