

## Johnson 'Ohana Foundation Farm to School Match with DONORSCHOOSE!

## Criteria:

- 1. Teach full time at an eligible public school, public charter school, or Head Start center.
- 2. Create a farm to school or school garden <u>project request</u>. Here are some examples:
  - Materials for school gardens, farm to school projects, tower gardens, and classroom gardens
  - Supplies to lead farm to school activities and/or taste tests with ingredients from school gardens, farmers markets, or sourced from local farmers
  - Cooking tools and equipment for nutrition education activities using local food ingredients
  - Tools and materials to compost food waste turning it into valuable soil for a school garden
- 3. Make sure to include the key word "'ĀINA In Schools" as well as any of the keywords that best describe your project: farm to table, farm to school, school garden, classroom garden, garden tower, harvest of the month.
- 4. Keep your total project goal under \$700, including taxes, shipping, fees, and the suggested donation to support DonorsChoose.
- 5. Once your project is approved, donations will be doubled while funding remains. That means a \$25 donation will become a \$50 donation!
